Meeting called to order at 5:00p.m. by Shirlynn Webb.

A. Opening Exercises

Ms. Helena DelMonte, Board Member, asked if there were any changes or revisions to the prior meeting minutes. There being none, Ms. DelMonte requested a motion to approve the Governing Board meeting minutes and run both meetings (Advantage Academy of Miami and The Charter School at Waterstone) simultaneously. Shirlynn Webb made the motion to approve the meeting minutes and run

the two meetings simultaneously, Bassema Iskandarani seconded the motion and all were in favor. Motion passed.

B. Public Comments

There were no public comments.

C. Principal Reports

Santa Fe Advantage Academy – Teresita Nieves, Principal, reported an enrollment of 235. Ms. Nieves reported the school is starting a new traffic pattern for dismissal. She also stated that workers cleared the palm trees to increase visibility from the street. The school will hold an open house on September 20 and they made approximately \$4,000 at the book fair. The school is currently using STEM resources for an after school club.

Doral International Academy of Math and Science – Vicky Ramos-Gomez, Principal, reported an opening enrollment of 748. Ms. Ramos-Gomez was excited to report on the recent ribbon cutting ceremony at the school and on September 8 the City of Doral honored the school at an "I am Doral" event?? The school hosted a surprise breakfast on planning day. Ms. Ramos-Gomez reported open house will be by grade level each night. Parent volunteers are helping with the traffic and they are forming the PTSO. The school is starting after school activities including dance and karate.

Everglades Preparatory Academy – Aimee Leyva, Principal, reported enrollment is at 996 students with a projection of 1034. Ms. Leyva said the school is hosting exchange students from Italy this year and students are also raising money for the Susan Komen cancer research. Many EPA graduates that now attend FAU have been accepted in to FAU's mock trial program which is the 4th most successful in the nation. Ms. Leyva also reported a local church developed a beautiful garden at the school. The school is adding dance classes this year and the football season is off to a great start this year.

AAMS CSW – Dr. Rebecca Valdes, Principal, reported a combined total enrollment of 1,133. Donna Baggs was named the new Assistant Principal for AAMS CSW and The Charter School at Waterstone. The school's open house is this week and STEAM will be on Fridays this year. Progress reports will go home on September 23 and picture day is the 30th.

Summerville Advantage Academy – Mary March, Principal, reported enrollment is at 545. The school is establishing several after-school activities and 100 plus students are participating in homework help. The school is teaming with Palm Glades to promote the cooperation and connections between the two schools. The teachers are participating in STEAM and the students collected \$500 by participating in a fundraiser for pediatric cancer.

Palm Glades Preparatory Academy – Archalena Coats, Principal, reported enrollment is at 706 with a projection of 825. Ms. Coats is excited about the open house next week and this year's meet and greet had the highest attendance ever. Ms. Coats reported the Eagle Dads are helping with dismissal and they have a presence on campus. Ms. Coats was happy to report on the first ever varsity baseball team and

home depot is helping to redesign the garden. The school is partnering with FCA and Huddletouch is providing pre-game meals.

D. Information Items

- 1. Mr. Strader informed the board that any questions regarding monthly financial reports may be directed to Ms. Merced at any time. Each board member receives a comprehensive monthly financial report.
- 2. Mr. Strader distributed an example of compliance reports submitted throughout the year via the Sponsor's computer based compliance management system.
- 3. Mr. Strader referred to the FY 16 audit reports distributed to board members previously and highlighted that no school under Advantage Academy of Miami, Inc. was found to have an audit finding or other area of non-compliance.
- 4. Mr. Strader discussed the 2016-2017 budget proposals and asked board members to approve the budgets under Section F. He discussed the challenges faced by two schools and the need for Principals to closely monitor enrollment.

 - b. A Title 1 budget for each of the above named schools is part of the budget packet and included in the board member packet for approval.
- 5. A copy of the 2016-2017 student handbook, employee handbook, and parent handbook were included in each board member's board packet. The board is required to review and approve these handbooks at the start of each school year.
- 6. A copy of the 2016-2017 board meeting schedule was discussed as included in the board member packet.
- 7. A copy of the 2016-2017 board member roster and liaison list was discussed as included in the board meeting packet.
- 8. A copy of the 2016-2017 student calendar was discussed as included in the board member packet.
- 9. A copy of the 2016-2017 teacher waiver exhibit was discussed as included in the board member packet and is included for board member approval.
